

The rest, of course, is predictable. Ex Rex



Halloween '07 Party Review by ROVER

Radio and "talking pictures" killed the hugely popular Vaudeville circuit in the the raunchier side of Vaudeville—Karen 1930's, and hundreds of variety performers joined the ranks of the unemployed standing in soup lines during the Depression. Too sad a theme for a par-Think again. Quing Lickity Split's giddy Halloween tete was a testament to the tact that the Fools Guild keeps the flame of Vaudeville burning and robust.

Aside from Danny Garland's clever redressing of the Burbank Moose Lodge as the backstage of the Moxie. Theater—including a museum of oddities (a la PT, Barnum) upstairs—and aside from a high-energy mix of irresistible, mostly-period dance music from DJ Christopher Paulsen—the true highlights of the evening were two halt-hour sets of variety acts of supreme quality.

Flappers, swung to "Ain't No Angel" and marathon-dancers did a high-steppin' Charleston. A quartet crooped Paddy Get Your Baby Out of Jail" in close harmonies, Our in-house "Baggy Pants" boys and the ghosts of George and Gracie relived classic comedy routines. J Paul delivered a brilliant epic by poet Shel Silverstein. Sa recreated Loie Fuller's stunning flowy-tabric dance—pertormance art WAY ahead of


ble props from her chemise; the Morgan sisters performed an athletically-cho-reographed "Hey Big Spender" that can only be described as jaw-dropping; and finally, Marni stripped off everything while a hula-hoop unfailingly circled her waist—with a double tassel-twirl finale. The approying roars of the audience attested to the fact that if the Vaudeville circuit were still around, these would have been its top-rated acts. And hosting the show was Dayid Springhorn, amusing in his inimitable way, despite having lost his house & possessions in the San Diego firestorm only days before.

Congrats to Heidi B, and to EVERY-ONE who participated. I cannot praise highly enough the Fools Guild's END-LESS ability to create events that stand head-and-šhoulders above other local happenings; we have a unique ability to explore a theme with details that stagger the imagination., It you missed Halloween, be sure to be there for New Years Eve in Bollywood—and it you can, join the fun in setting up the show before-hand—you'll be glad you did! —Rover




